Clarifying the meaning of words, using moments from the text that reflect the meaning of words or phrases






Picturing key moments, characters or settings in a story, drawing on their reading and background knowledge to make sense of the text.





Retelling and Sequencing

Retell the story orally. Order the main events in a story. Recalling key moments from the text, to support understanding and to develop further writing skills by internalising story structures, techniques, plot...








Discussing characters' thoughts and feelings at key moments in a story






Synonyms




























Roll, Read, Draw
