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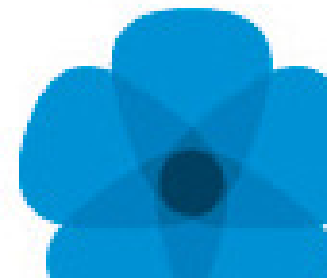
Overview

A set of radial questions to consider around the teaching of language for GCSE, intended to support departmental reflection and discussion.

Points to consider when using this resource

These questions do not pretend to offer a 'right' answer but some straightforward prompts for open discussion within departments or leadership teams that can inform action planning.



When do we start formally introducing elements of the language papers?

Do we build up towards the GCSE papers, or does teaching towards particular questions dominate our planning approach?

Which teaching approaches do we use most often/most effectively?

How much curriculum time do we give to the explicit teaching of writing? Is this enough?

Do we give language as much teaching time as literature?

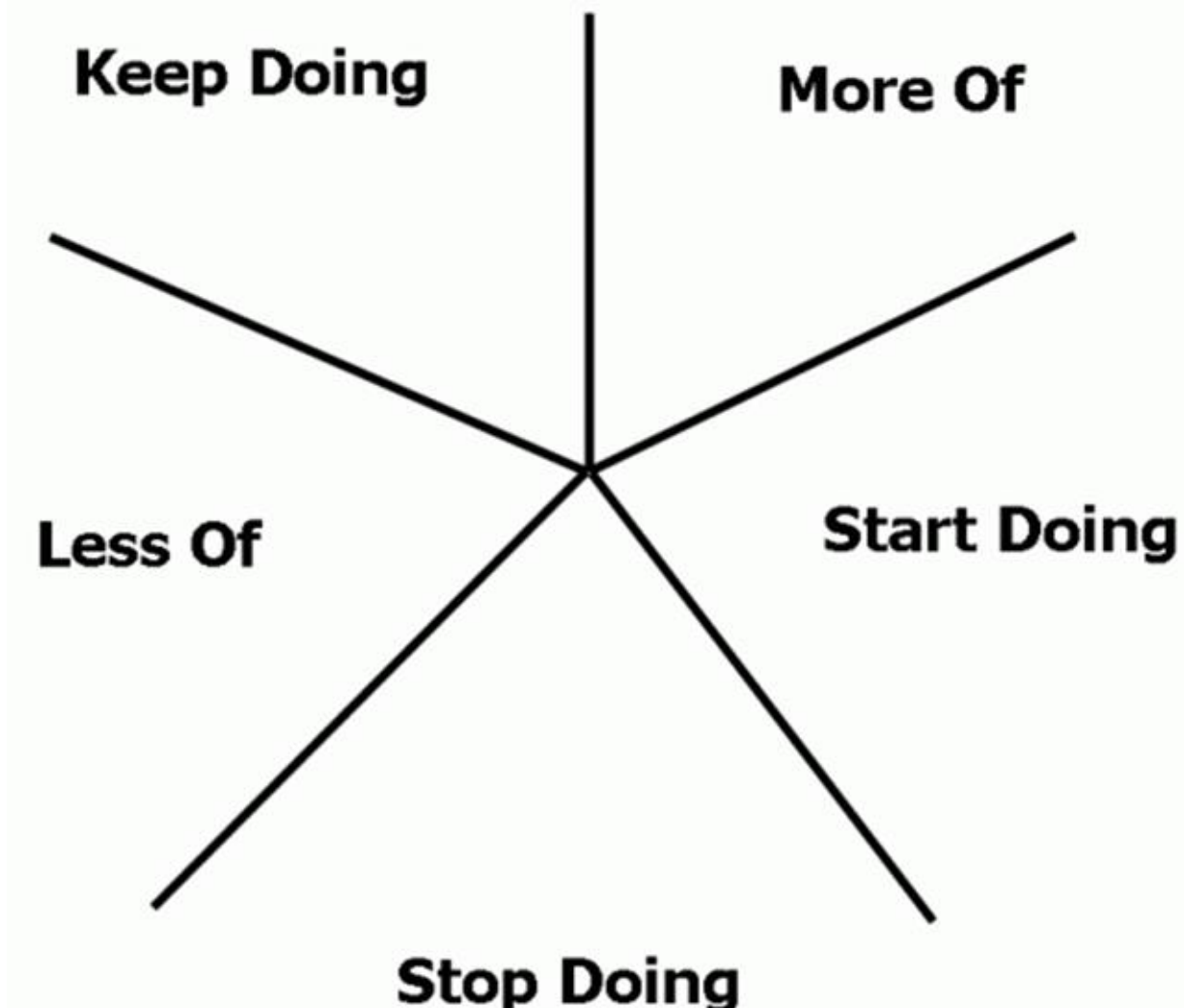
How are we teaching GCSE language?

Are there particular points in the course where we focus on language exclusively?

How do we integrate elements of teaching for the language reading papers with literature teaching?
